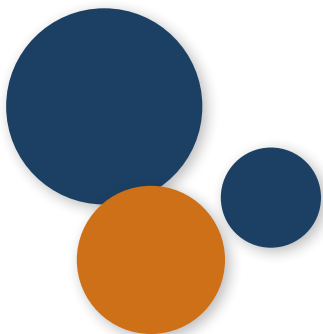




Greater Reading Young Professionals Gala
